Ceilings in patient bed areas including Bed Rooms, Bed Bays and Recovery areas should be a minimum of 2700mm Bed Rooms for bariatric care may require an increase in ceiling height to accommodate lifting equipment In critical care bed areas such as ICU, CCU, HDU and

Patient safety is a serious global public health concern It is estimated that there is a 1 in 3 million risk of dying while travelling by aeroplane In comparison, the risk of patient death occurring due to a preventable medical accident, while receiving health care, is estimated to be 1 in 300

Swing Bed Admission, Transfer, and Discharge Rights

42 CFR §48312 (a)(1) states, transfer and discharge includes movement of a resident to a bed outside of the certified facility whether that bed is in the same physical plant or not Transfer and discharge does not refer to movement of a resident to a bed within the same certified facility

Prevention and Safe Removal of Bedbugs - HUD

Inspect in and around sleeping and resting areas at home once a month Look for signs of bedbug activity, active infestations will have fecal spotting, live or dead bedbugs, shed skins and bedbug eggs Avoid used furniture and mattresses, especially discarded furniture and mattresses

HELPING PATIENTS WITH PERSONAL HYGIENE

- Make sure that the patient’s privacy is protected; close the door or draw the curtains around the bed
- Use warm (115° F, 461° C) water
- Cover the patient with a bath blanket
- Place a moisture-absorbent bed protector under the patient’s hips
- Ask the patient to flex the knees and separate the legs

Nursing Hours per Patient Day Model (NHPPD)

The Guiding Principles apply to acute patient care areas and mental health in-patient units The NHPPD model is not a rigid, mandatory determinant of staffing It provides a mechanism to ensure flexibility in the supply of nursing hours to meet the variable demand for patient care

Sliding patient to headboard Options: • “Conveyer belt” sheet that cycles around the bed by pressing a button or using a crank • Install handles on existing sheets • Use same system but step to head of bed instead of swinging body • Hold person and lift to headboard instead of using the sheet and person Most important change
