Using Psychotropic Medications during Pregnancy and Lactation General Issues for all Psychotropic Medications 1,2,3,4 Avoid medications in first trimester, if possible Several of these drugs are folate antagonists All women on anticonvulsants should receive extra folate AVOID valproate as a mood stabilizer in pregnancy

Prescribing in pregnant women: guide to general principles

All drugs in pregnancy should be prescribed in the lowest effective dose for the shortest possible time Drugs may act synergistically in Drugs in lactation While it is not within the scope of this article to discuss the principles of prescribing in lactation, it is nec-

conclusion Chronic maternal use of the drug throughout pregnancy can cause neonatal withdrawal Excreted into milk May cause withdrawal symptoms in nursing infants, lethargy and weight loss, so should be avoided during lactation amiodarone C Crosses human placenta No well-controlled human data but reported to cause congenital

DRUGS IN PREGNANCY

The pregnancy risk to benefit ratio is defined as the risk to the fetus compared to the benefits to the mother Components of this ratio are the 1) genotype of mother and fetus, 2) embryonic stage at exposure, 3) dose, and 4) exposure to other drugs or environmental agents that may increase
