### **Stuttering: Straight Talk for Teachers**

speech therapy helps the child learn to talk in an easier manner, even quite fluently, and to have healthy attitudes and feelings about talking

- Stuttering is not caused by psychological differences Children do not begin stuttering because they are more anxious, more shy, or more

therapy! Many SLPs teach a combination of fluency shaping and stuttering modification strategies to help their students Fluency Shaping Strategies

Changing the rate, breathing, or tension to help prevent a stutter The focus here is fluency and doing what you can to increase fluent utterances Easy Onset - starting your airflow prior to turning

### **Stuttering Assessment and Treatment for Preschool-age ...**

review later - each take turns looking at fluency data At home - parents use fluency enhancing techniques and may be asked to track frequency of use (pausing 10 min per day, etc) When to move to direct treatment methods Yaruss and Reeves recommend moving to direct ...

### **Children With Reading Difficulties**

to avoid direct instruction School-aged children receive hours of direct instruction from teachers, tutors, and their parents In occupational therapy for reading, the child needs to feel in control of achieving his or her goals 3 Use various contexts Context provides opportunities for transferring and generalizing skills

develop to correct production without direct intervention If a child cannot correctly imitate a sound, we say that he/she is not stimulable for that sound In this case, direct intervention services with the SLP may be required Direct intervention will help the child learn and practice correct production of the misarticulated or omitted sounds
