Hazardous Remediation Waste Management Requirements ...

hazardous waste When EPA or an authorized State determines that media do not "contain" hazardous waste, RCRA does not generally pose a barrier to remediation because permitting requirements, LDRs (generally) and MTRs do not apply to media that do not contain hazardous waste...

well as long-term cleanup of hazardous waste sites became the National Contingency Plan (NCP), revised in 1982 and 1985 Under CERCLA, the NCP outlined the level of clean-up necessary at a Superfund site and established procedures to be followed for discovery, response, and remediation of a hazardous waste site¹
