common causes of low back pain The disc, which is constituted by the nucleus pulposus, annulus fibrosus and cartilaginous endplate (Figure 2), is mainly designed to absorb and distribute the loads experienced by the spine and its shape has been shown to play an important role in the disc biomechanics Table 2 presents

CDC Recommendations for Nonopioid Treatments in the ...

Selection of therapy: role of pain mechanism and diagnosis • NSAIDs for nociceptive pain (eg, osteoarthritis, muscular back pain) • Selected antidepressants or anticonvulsants for neuropathic pain (eg, diabetic neuropathy, postherpetic neuralgia) or fibromyalgia); topical lidocaine for localized neuropathic pain

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within three to four weeks, the treatment should be either modified or discontinued Reconsideration of diagnosis should also occur in the event of poor response to a seemingly rational intervention 8 Surgical Interventions Surgery should be contemplated within the context of expected functional outcome and not purely for the purpose of pain

MEDICAL POLICY Acupuncture

As mentioned earlier, chronic low back pain is defined as back pain that lasts longer than three months During the evaluation of chronic back pain, it is important to rule out any injuries or disease processes that could place you at risk for further injury if not treated or addressed Clarification of the diagnosis is a key step in creating
