B Selection of Fattening Cattle To insure a profitable income from fattening cattle, these factors are to be considered: 1 Age- Younger animals require longer feeding period Feed is utilized for maintenance, growth and fattening Older animals take shorter time for fattening Preferred age of cattle for fattening is 2-3 years old 2

Sheep Production and Management

To grow to maximum size, ewe and ram lambs must be born early On most purebred sheep operations, breeding occurs in July and August This usually results in a suboptimal lamb crop percentage because most ewes are more fertile during September and October A purebred sheep operation produces stud rams, commercial rams, and replacement ewes
